FRENCH IMMERSION CAMPS



Centre nautique de l'Istorlet Îles-de-la-Madeleine, Québec

Nautical Camp

Ages: Y 12 to 14
Fee: \$350 (tx.incl)
Dates: August 4 to 10

The Centre nautique de l'Istorlet is a wonderful facility located on the southernmost island of Havre-Aubert, Îles-de-la-Madeleine. This five-day camp for *French immersion students* provides a full schedule of exciting activities featuring sailing, kayaking, windsurfing, cycling and canoeing. Campers may share the facility with Francophone students from Québec. This provides a unique experience of the language and culture of the Îles-de-la-Madeleine.



Sea Kayak Adventure

Ages: Y 15 to 17
Fee: \$ 450 (taxes included)
Dates: July 21 to 27

This five-day wilderness adventure camp is being offered to *French immersion students*. It is a kayak tripping adventure, carrying food and gear in the kayak and tenting overnight at various places along the coast. The campers



will be accompanied by professional staff of l'Istorlet. Activities will include visiting caves and tunnels, birds and seal watching, clam digging and more.

Grade 5 Core Immersion Camp

This camp is for Grade 5 students who are presently in Core French. They could be students who would like to have a **jump-start** to late immersion or Core students who just want to have more French language. **Parents are Welcome to Volunteer and learn too!**

Camp Date: August 23rd to August 25th.

Cost: Members \$75. Non-Members \$100.

Location: On the Belleisle Bay just 2 kms from the ferry.

Camp Pascobac

This is a 5 day **total French Immersion camp** for 11 and 12 year old French Immersion children. The camp is located on the beautiful Belleisle Bay less than 2 kms from the ferry. Some activities of the camp will be swimming, games, sports, crafts, campfires and more. If you would like to volunteer at the camp and you want to practice your own French skills please let us know.

Date: August 18th to August 22nd

Cost: \$150 for 2002/2003 members.
