The Centre international d'apprentissage du français at the Shippagan Campus of the Université de Moncton, will open its doors this summer. Although its primary objective is to provide French language training for students from abroad, the Centre will be offering a number of camps during the summer.

One of these camps is an intensive immersion week for **Middle School** School students (grades 7 – 8), which will take place from DATE. Entitled **Marine Biology and Agriculture**, the week's activities are designed to provide participants with the occasion to discover the influence of coastal waters on life in the Acadian Peninsula. Students will participate in a number of hands-on activities (fishing with nets, laboratory work, peat farming, and so on).

Students will be housed in supervised University accommodation. 5 qualified monitors will be available 24 hours a day. Participants will be expected to arrive on Sunday, July 29, in the evening, and be expected to leave on Friday, August 3, after lunch.

Activities include:

- A visit to the Marine Centre
- Fishing with a net
- A visit to a peat farm
- A day exploring the fishing industry
- A day at a blueberry farm
- Sports activities (evenings at the beach, volleyball, etc)

Aug. 3: Music and departure

Please note that, where possible, students will participate in hands-on activities at the various sites. Time will be spent each day discussing the activities and providing input to participants' command of French (written and oral).

A detailed schedule will be mailed to applicants.

The team of teachers and monitors will ensure that your stay is a profitable and an enjoyable one! Transportation to all activities will be provided by the Centre, using a wheel-chair accessible bus.
